THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE.

A Move for the Erection of a New Poor House.

All members of the board at the morning session of the present of supervision yesterday morning.

The first matter considered was a petition from the Lowell & Hastings railroad asking permission to erect a bridge across Grand river at Lowell.

The committee to whom was referred the purchase of a lot in one of the cemeteries for the burial of paupers, reported that no suitable lot can be purchased at less than \$100 or \$200.

The committee was informed however, by one of the cemetery commissioners that they were looking for more ground, as nearly all of the present grounds except a few high priced spots, are owned by the state.

The committee on buildings, to whom was referred the petition of S. L. Brown, for damages for three victory trees cut from his farm by an inmate of the poor house, reported that the trees were bought from the tenant on the farm, and that Mr. L. Brown should sue the tenant and not the county.

The committee on court house submitted its report showing payment to the contractors to date aggregating \$90,887.73. Included in this amount is all about \$10,000, making this amount paid for the labor and material, still remaining for the completion of the building.

The following resolution offered by Mr. Brown was referred to the committee on public buildings: "Resolved, That the erection of a necessary building on what is known as the Kent County Poor farm is a public improvement, both as to the health of the inmates and as a matter of economy to the taxpayers of Kent county, said building to be erected on the site of the old building on the farm."

GENS GOING UP.

The passage of the silver bill in this country has affected the jewelry trade in more than one particular. The price of sterling tableware has already been increased, and now advice from Europe indicates that, owing to the new law, the increase in the value of the Indian rupee has caused the prices of pearls and fancy stones to rise to unprecedented figures.

As you probably know, the money standard in India is the silver rupee. Last February this coin was worth about 18.4d. in English money, or about 34 cents in United States money.

There are some lots of Indian cut goods on hand, however, which were received before the increase, and which advances at the old rate of exchange were made. These are still purchasable at the old price.

During the next few months we may expect a decided advance in the price of pearls, rubies and emeralds. Sapphire will probably be less affected, but their sale has been limited, and dealers will naturally sell old stock at the usual prices.

Millions of Money Letters.

The postoffice department at Washington has issued a notice calling public attention to the fact that over six million pieces of mail matter were returned to the dead letter office in the past year by reason of incorrect, illegible or insecure addresses. It is a daily average of over 20,000 pieces, the loss of which naturally must often cause great inconvenience to the persons to whom they are addressed.

The greater portion of the matter referred to is not called for and is sent to the dead letter office under the address of the sender in the inclosure, or some clew to his whereabouts. Letters containing any inclosure of value are returned unopened and are returned to the proper identification. If they are not called for within two years they are sold at auction and the proceeds paid to the treasury.

Of the unclaimed and undelivered mail matter received at the dead letter office in the past year 28,000 contained money, amounting in all to \$48,842, 4/10 and had inclosures of postal notes in small sums, usually less than \$5, amounting to \$7,000, were found to contain checks, notes, commercial paper, etc., in the sum of \$1,471,571, with 46,000 contained paid and canceled orders, receipts evidencing payments of money, deeds, mortgages and general miscellaneous papers.
