PRISON FURNITURE: The gentlemen who discussed the house of correction furniture scheme at the board of trade rooms made the whole matter tedious by attempting to discuss the broad question of prison reform.

It was not the business of that meeting to direct or suggest what employment should be given the convicts at Iowa; it was enough for the meeting to express its disapprobation of a prison furniture factory.

It does not seem to be the business of the warden and managers of the prison to make other arrangements to employ the convicts if money is refused to enlarge the furniture plant.

No doubt this subject has been thoroughly explained by the prison officials and they should be consulted. They have asked for \$40,000 to put in a furniture factory, but it does not follow that they are at their wits end if that request is refused.

Let the committee of the legislature on the state house of correction consult the prison officials and make further report before further action is taken.

A GOLD BASIS: A London banker, Henry C. Westfield, makes the statement that the deposits in all the banks of England and Scotland amount to \$3,000,000,000.

He further states that the supply of gold in Great Britain is estimated at \$90,000,000. You will know deposits are payable in gold a run on the banks would result in such a panic as the world has never seen.

This statement of the amount of gold in Great Britain is beyond doubt incorrect, but it is certain that the amount of gold in both Europe and America is far less than the liabilities of the banks. All kinds of legal tender coins do not amount to a third of the bank deposits.

But gold alone is not sufficient to absorb the liability of the banks in all nations where gold is held as the only money standard.

It is a false basis, and because it is false is the reason there are periods of depression, when confidence is shattered by fears of a collapse growing out of the failure of some great banking house, like the Barings and Jay Cook.

It was very gratifying to see members of the board of trade, members of the Furniture Manufacturers' association and members of the labor unions sitting together to maintain the honor and dignity of free labor.

It was a hearty recognition of the wisdom and rights of organized labor by Grand Rapids capital that speaks well for the liberality of soul in our manufacturers that brings them in close sympathy with the honest labor upon which their lean and upon which they are united by a common interest.
