

SECRETARY BLAINE'S CORRESPONDENCE WITH HUDIN.

Italy has no claim for indemnity for the New Orleans riot. Unless she makes a case in the courts.

WASHINGTON, April 15.—The correspondence between Premier Rudin and Secretary Blaine is given out for publication tonight. The first epistle was from Rudin, dated April 9. He said the Italian government asked nothing but a prompt institution of judicial proceedings through the regular channels.

The premier only hints at indemnity for the victims relatives. Mr. Blaine sent a note to Imperial April 4, alluding to the matter, and enclosing a telegram which Baron Fava received from Rome, which the Italian request was very simple, and that their right to demand and obtain justice and indemnity was unquestioned.

Mr. Blaine denied that he said indemnity was due to the families of the victims, but that he would take the matter under consideration and assured Italy every Italian subject wronged by a violation of a treaty would be recompensed.

Mr. Blaine said there is some difference between the riots, and agreed to look into the matter. He said a report from New Orleans does not allow criminal proceedings under the United States statute, he would urge the state to prosecute the guilty.
