THE OFFICIAL ALLIANCE GREETING TO THE NEW PARTY.

Indorsement from Alliance Headquarters of the Work Done at Cincinnati. What President Polk's Official Bureau Says About the People's Party.

The great Cincinnati conference is a thing of the past. It has made history. In the United States of America the first step toward the formation of a new great political party is taken, the chief corner stone being equal rights to all special privileges to none, and this party standing on this foundation is one against which the united cohorts of greed, avarice and power cannot prevail. It must win and will rule.

The New Mexico Alliance disesteeming the adoption of a new constitution and bylaws, such as will remove some restrictions which have operated against the people, and proposing a new constitution beginning to be an awakening there also. About 75 per cent. of the population speaks the Spanish language, and the territory is one of the most fertile in the United States.

The membership of the colored Alliance is increasing beyond count. National Headquarters of the People's Party organization is prospering beyond all precedent as far as organization is concerned. Its greatest hindrance is the lack of the great general press, and its status is far in excess of ability to supply.

The Alliance has had no greater glory in any other state than in Indiana, but it is now conquering. Thirty-three million dollars worth of property has been assigned to the organization, and the bureau has official information to the effect that the P. P. A. has a strong hold in many counties, will soon join the Alliance and also the Patrons of Husbandry.
