ELECTRIC CANAL BOATS.  
Introduction of the New Motive Power  
Would Render the Industry.

There has appeared in a mechanical publication the following statement: An electric engineer of Buffalo, engineer to reduce very largely the cost of transportation on the Erie canal. His plan is to adapt the electric current to a cable of about half that of horse power, he argues, why can it not take the place of canal mules with a like reduction of cost? The pole and other appliances for the overhead wires, and in fact the whole plant, covering the whole length of the canal, could be readily arranged without hindrance to navigation. The span would not be too wide for a miller.

There are a thousand and one objections to it which present themselves to any mind. Take, for instance, the trolley scheme. It must be remembered that in a canal boat and not the car that is to be run now. The horse car is forced to go in a certain line by the track rails. It would not be possible to have a canal boat so far from side to side that it would be possible to keep a trolley wheel on that set wire? Then there would be the continual problem of running the wires blowing down and in other ways being damaged. How are the trolleys to be managed, going through locks? Boats, you know, do not travel up and down grade as in inclined planes on a car does—they are always on a level. What are you to do with the sixteen locks with the trolley system? I think the trolley system on the canal is entirely out of question. It embraces so many points where complications might arise, and so much cost of construction, that I think it is entirely impracticable. Suppose it were reduced. Assuming that all the 7,000 or more boats on the canal were on that one, or two, wires. At any time a boat is liable to leak or to have an accident of its own. What then is to be done? It would block the whole canal. That could not be afforded.

There would have to be special boats built for the introduction of motors and propelling wheels. That would throw the whole army of canal boats out of its normal use of the canal, for no boats that did not run by electricity could navigate those waters. Can we afford to do this? The cost of the motor in a canal boat would increase its tonnage greatly and, I would judge, its operating capacity almost 50 per cent.—Albany Argus.
