His excuse was that the woman had accused him of having a wife in America. Thereupon Mr. Sewarick, who had been called in as a complainant, provoked her husband in the manner alleged it was no wonder she was assaulted, and the charge to which Dwire had pleaded guilty was forthwith dismissed.

At Leyland last week a pork butcher who had thrown a plate at his wife, knocked her on to the floor, attempted to put her head into the fire, chased her out into the garden and then threw her against a water butt and kicked her with his clogs, was sentenced to pay a fine of twenty-one shillings or go to prison for a month. A separation order was made at the same time, and I suppose the magistrates will say that if they had sent the man to jail without an alternative, he would only have been depriving the wife and children of the means of subsistence.

What is the remedy? Clearly, as pointed out the other day—the last. These forms of brutality can only be effectively dealt with on the homeopathic principle. My husband has been called to a system said to be in force in Germany, by which a man may be imprisoned for an assault on his wife or children without causing the punishment to react to the further disadvantage of the victims. To sentence them to the island is to send them to the doors of mercy upon them. Really what can be done? We do not treat boys so, and why should not girls be as well treated as boys? We assume to know that young offenders are often misled, and with the care may be saved to themselves and to society. Why should we abandon to the mercenary administration of the island without offering her a chance of reformation.—Harper's Weekly.
